Village Link Walk Four, Llanidloes to Llangurig

A superb walk of about 5 miles with good views over the Severn Valley and passing the picturesque Marsh's Pool.

From the Old Market Hall walk along Short Bridge Street and, after crossing the bridge, turn left and walk along Penygreen Road for about half a mile until you reach the left turn signposted to Llangurig. Take this road and, after crossing Felindre Bridge, ignore the two right turns and continue to where your road turns sharp right.

At this point you will see a finger post indicating a bridleway through a field gate ahead of you, next to a bungalow.

Go through the gate and follow the bridleway ahead to the river, turn right to the bridge and, after crossing it, continue along the lane until you exit into a field.

Walk diagonally right to the far corner of the field, passing a telephone pole on your left towards the middle of the field, until you reach the gate into the wood..

Go through the gate and follow the bridleway to Cefn y Bwlch Farm, skirt the sheds, keeping them to your right and rejoin the bridleway as it climbs the hill and then breaks out into open fields once more.

Follow the way-marks, keeping the fence-line to your right, down the hill to a point where the track passes between fences, through trees and a particularly muddy bottom, before continuing through a field gate and then into a conifer plantation.

The track continues through the plantation and out, through fields once more past the very pretty Marsh's Pool (Private Property). Keeping the pool to your left, follow the track over a small bridge and along a short length of lane to the field gate.

Follow the way-marks, bearing left across the fields to Pen Hyle Mawr Farm. Go into the farmyard itself and exit to your right along the (long) main farm drive to the tarmac road.

Turn left along the road and walk the last half mile or so into Llangurig.
