

### **Village Link Walk Three, Llanidloes to Tylwch**

A walk along minor roads and farmland footpaths for about 6.25 miles to the hamlet of Tylwch. There are no shops in Tylwch and you should carry all your food and drink needs with you.

From the Old Market Hall, walk along Great Oak Street and bear sharp right at the top by the Minerva Centre. After about 150 yards, turn left along Gorn road and follow it up the bank and over the by-pass bridge.

After crossing the bridge, follow the road round to your left through the houses and then right, up the hill, as you join Glyndwr's Way.

Continue along the road, over the mini-roundabout, for about 1.5 miles until the road bears sharp right into Cefngwylgi Fawr Farm. Carry on straight through the farm and along the way-marked bridleway to the tarmac road.

Turn left along the road and continue for about a mile to the small cross-roads. Walk straight over the cross-roads and, after about 200 yards, fork right. After a further 250 yards, take the footpath signposted off to your right.

Follow the marked footpath up the hill for about half a mile to the corner of Tylwch Wood. Turn right down the hill at this point and, after about 50 yards, cross the stile on your left, into the wood.

The path through the wood is marked and is quite distinct. On crossing the stile out of the wood, bear right down the field and out, through the field gate, onto the road and bear right\* into Tylwch itself.

\*(If you wish to return to Llanidloes on foot, you may turn left on reaching the road and walk along the side of the valley, following the route of the old railway line just below you, for about three quarters of a mile. Just before the road crosses the river near Pen y Graig Farm, turn left along the bridleway lane as it climbs the hill, becoming a tarmac road at Old Chapel. Follow the road back to the cross-roads and then re-trace your route back to Llanidloes)
